

### **Maths**

This half term the children will learn about fractions and time.

For fractions, the children will be looking at how to part a whole. Focussing on halves, quarters and thirds.

For time, the children will be looking at how to tell the time to the hour, past and to the hour as well as half past the hour. There will be a lot of practical learning involved in this.

### **English**

This half term the children will be looking at how to write instructions and fables. They will investigate the methods in which writers create these pieces of writing and use this knowledge to create their own versions.

### **Art**

This project teaches children about portraiture. They analyse the portraits of Tudor monarchs and compare Tudor portraits and selfies today. They use photo editing software to create royal portraits.

### **Computing**

In this unit, learners will be using a computer to create music. They will listen to a variety of pieces of music and consider how music can make them think and feel. Learners will compare creating music digitally and non-digitally. Learners will look at patterns and purposefully create music.

### **RE**

The children will learn about Jumu'ah; these are Friday prayers. Before Jumu'ah, many Muslims wash, put on perfume or aftershave and dress in clean clothes. Just after lunchtime, worshippers meet at the mosque to say special prayers and listen to a talk by the Imam. The importance of saying Friday prayers is mentioned in the Qur'an and Muhammad called Friday the best day.

## **Beach Class Summer 1 2024-2025**

### **Science**

This project teaches children about growth in animals by exploring the life cycles of some familiar animals. They build on learning about the survival of humans by identifying the basic needs of animals for survival, including food,

### **PSHE**

This half term the children will focus on 'Being My Best' where they will look at how to be healthy and what key organs do for our bodies. The children will also learn some basic first aid and how to encourage each other to succeed with challenges.

### **History**

This project teaches children about the English and British monarchy from AD 871 to the present day. Using timelines, information about royal palaces, portraits and other historical sources, they build up an understanding of the monarchs and then research six of the most significant sovereigns.

### **D&T - Cut, Stitch and Join**

This project teaches children about fabric home products and the significant British brand Cath Kidston. They learn about sewing patterns and using a running stitch and embellishments before making a sewn bag tag.
